






Q4 4\. Is the gender you identify with the same as your sex registered at birth?*




Q6 6\. Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?*







Q10 10\. Which type of school did you attend for the most time between the ages between the ages 11 and 16? (if you changed schools, please base your answer on the last two years of your education).*





Q11 11\. Did either of your parents attend university by the time you were 18?*



Q12 12\. What was the occupation of your main household earner when you were about 14?*




Q13 13\. Are you a primary carer for a child or children under 18?*
